2026 ALSAM Addiction Medicine for the Primary Care Provider Request for Proposals

PURPOSE:

The Alabama Society of Addiction Medicine, through a grant provided from opioid settlement funds, is hosting several half day conferences in 2026 to provide education to primary care providers on how to provide evidence base substance use care to patients. These conferences will be free to attendees.

AUDIENCE:

These conferences will be presented in a 3-4-hour block in conjunction with other conferences. Attendees could be physicians, advanced practice providers, or other healthcare workers interested in addiction medicine.

PRESENTATION OPTIONS:

ALSAM will accept presentations in the following formats:

- Panel discussion
- Lecture session

LENGTH OF SESSIONS:

Sessions should be 1 hour in length.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SPEAKERS:

- All speakers must commit to the presentation at the designated time during the conference.
- Speakers should grant permission for hard copy and online distribution of any submitted supplemental resource material(s).
